**Course Objectives:** We will cover the first six chapters of the textbook. We aim to have a solid and sound understanding of real vector spaces. We will study basic properties of such vector spaces, linear maps between them and operators, systems of linear equations, matrices, eigenvalues and eigenspaces of operators, and inner-products on vector spaces.
